Paul Vick completes school theatre

[FIRST LOOK + PLANS] Paul Vick Architects has completed this theatre and sixth-form centre at Brentford School for Girls

The 160-seat building has two 8m-high stainless-steel meshes that frame the main entrance, forming the front edge of the reception area and a covered playground area.

A galvanised and polyester powder-coated steel mesh engulfs the rest of the structure.
